- 40 (C) The term "searchable website" means a website that
- 41 allows the public to:
- 42 (i) Search and aggregate federal funding by any
- 43 element required by subsection (2) of this section;
- 44 (ii) Ascertain through a single search the total
- amount of federal funding awarded to an entity by a federal award 45
- 46 by fiscal year;

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- 48 amount of federal funding awarded to an entity by a federal award
- 49 described by fiscal year; and
- 50 (iv) Download data included in the outcome from
- 51 searches.
- 52 (2) Not later than January 1, 2024, the Mississippi
- 53 Department of Finance and Administration shall, in conjunction
- 54 with the federal E-Government Act of 2002 (Public Law 107-347; 44
- 55 USC 3501 note), and the Office of Federal Procurement Policy Act
- 56 (41 USC 403 et seq.), ensure the existence and operation of a
- 57 single searchable website, accessible by the public at no cost to
- 58 access, that includes for each federal award:
- 59 (a) The name of the entity in the State of Mississippi
- 60 receiving the award;
- (b) The amount of the award;
- 62 (c) Information on the award, including transaction
- 63 type, funding agency, the North American Industry Classification
- 64 System code or Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance number
- 65 (where applicable), program source, and an award title descriptive
- of the purpose of each funding action;
- 67 (d) The location of the entity receiving the award and
- 68 the primary location of performance under the award, including the
- 69 city, state, congressional district, and country;

- 73 (f) Any other relevant information specified by the

- 75 The website shall include data for fiscal year 2024, and each
- 76 fiscal year thereafter. The Director of the Department of Finance
- 77 and Administration is authorized to designate one or more federal
- 78 agencies to participate in the development, establishment,
- 79 operation, and support of the single website. In the initial
- 80 designation, or in subsequent instructions and quidance, the
- 81 director may specify the scope of the responsibilities of each
- 82 such agency.
- 83 (3) State and local agencies shall comply with the
- 84 instructions and guidance issued by the Director of the Department
- 85 of Finance and Administration under this subsection, and shall
- 86 provide appropriate assistance to the director upon request, so as
- 87 to assist the director in ensuring the existence and operation of
- 88 the single website.
- 89 (4) The website established under this section:
- 90 (a) May use as the source of its data the Federal
- 91 Procurement Data System, Federal Assistance Award Data System, and
- 92 Grants.gov, if all of these data sources are searchable through
- 93 the website and can be accessed in a search on the website
