- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any determination of the
- 7 Mississippi Board of Chiropractic Examiners, a chiropractor
- 8 licensed under Title 73, Chapter 6, Mississippi Code of 1972, may
- 9 advertise in Lee County, Mississippi, as a chiropractic
- 10 neurologist if the chiropractor:
- 11 (a) Has successfully completed a neurology chiropractic
- 12 program at a school accredited in the field; and
- 13 (b) Holds a current certification from either the
- 14 American Chiropractic Neurology Board (ACNB) or the International
- 15 Board of Chiropractic Neurology (IBCN).
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
