6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums herein
8	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
9	necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
10	Capital Expense Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by
11	the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
12	Ethics Commission for the period beginning July 1, 2022, and
13	ending June 30, 2023\$ 24,961.00.
14	This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
15	agency operational expenses.
16	SECTION 2. In addition to all other sums herein
17	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
18	necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
19	Capital Expense Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by

20	the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the Mississippi
21	Emergency Management Agency for the period beginning July 1, 2022,
22	and ending June 30, 2023\$ 6,518,942.00.
23	This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
24	agency operational expenses.
25	SECTION 3. In addition to all other sums herein
26	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
27	necessary, is appropriated out of any money to the credit of the
28	Capital Expense Fund, and allocated in a manner as determined by
29	the Treasurer's Office, to defray the expenses of the State
30	Department of Health for the period upon passage of this act and
31	ending June 30, 2024\$ 1,103,950.00.
32	This additional appropriation is for the purpose of defraying
33	legal expenses.
34	SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
35	and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.
