- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof

140	SECTION 5. None of the funds appropriated by this	act shall
141	be expended for any purpose that is not actually requir	red or
142	necessary for performing any of the powers or duties of	the Board
143	of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning,	or any of
144	the powers or duties of any institution under the juris	diction of

- 145 the board of trustees, that are authorized by the Mississippi
- 146 Constitution of 1890, state or federal law, or rules or
- 147 regulations that implement state or federal law.
- 148 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 149 budget requests of the individual institutes, laboratories and
- 150 programs consolidated in this bill for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be
- 151 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 152 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 153 provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.
- 154 **SECTION 7.** The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 155 Higher Learning shall report yearly to the Legislature any
- 156 institution not in compliance with Section 97-11-51, Mississippi
- 157 Code of 1972, which prohibits deficit spending.
- 158 **SECTION 8.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and
- 159 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be
- 160 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of
- 161 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.
- 162 **SECTION 9.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 163 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 164 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 165 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 166 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 167 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 168 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 169 made without competitive bids.

- SECTION 10. None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized for expenditure under this act shall be used for research in which a human embryo is killed or destroyed.
- SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for

actions contrary to this provision.

- 180 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, One Million Three Hundred Seventy-five Thousand Dollars 181 182 (\$1,375,000.00), or so much thereof, is hereby appropriated out of 183 any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code 184 185 of 1972, and allocated in a manner as determined by the 186 Treasurer's Office, to the Mississippi State University - State 187 Chemical Laboratory for the purpose of purchasing equipment to 188 enhance the laboratory capabilities including, but not limited to, 189 equipment for water quality testing.
- SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
 act, One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) is provided
 to the University of Mississippi State Court Education Program
 to defray the expenses of newly elected justice court judges and
 newly elected chancery and circuit clerks.

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SECTION 14. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
SECTION 15. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2023.
