SENATE BILL NO. 3008

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2024. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the University of Mississippi Medical 8 9 Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 180,875,758.00. 10 11 SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for 12 13 expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student 14 fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of the 15 16 University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024..... 17 18\$ 1,662,877,883.00.

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19 SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated and authorized for 20 expenditure under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the 21 22 School of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of 23 Nursing, the School of Health Related Professions, the School of 24 Population Health, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center Service Area. The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall 25 26 prepare and make available to the Legislature an accounting of 27 expenditures for each of the divisions listed in this section at 28 the beginning of the legislative session.

29 SECTION 4. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it 30 is the intention of the Legislature to enhance recognition of 31 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting 32 qualified registered nurses.

SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 33 34 act, and the funds authorized to be expended in Section 2 of this 35 act, none may be used to provide medical services on behalf of any state agency, institution or political subdivision, except to the 36 37 extent that such agency, institution or political subdivision 38 reimburses the hospital for the cost of the services provided. 39 Upon the rendering of medical services to any such agency, 40 institution or political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an invoice for the charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) 41 42 days. In the event that payment is not made within ninety (90) days, the hospital shall discontinue providing services to that 43

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SECTION 6. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 46 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 47 48 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 49 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.

50 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 51 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for 52 Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 53 54 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 55 budget request process.

56 SECTION 8. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this 57 act, the following sums, or so much of those sums as may be 58 necessary, are derived out of any money in the State Treasury to 59 the credit of the Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Sections 60 27-65-75 and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, as follows: Education activities or scholarships \$ 6,888,029.00. 61 (a) 62 Rural Physicians Scholarship Program \$ 340,000.00. (b) 63 Rural Dentists Scholarship Program \$ 105,000.00. (C) 64 TOTAL.....\$ 7,333,029.00. 65 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 2 of this act, Two Million Three Hundred Eighty Thousand 66 67 Four Hundred Thirty-one Dollars (\$2,380,431.00) shall be derived from the Health Care Expendable Fund created in Section 43-13-407,

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69 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the support and maintenance of the 70 University of Mississippi Medical Center.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the sum of Four Hundred Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$420,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural Dentists Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 776, 2013 Regular Session.

SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of this act, Two Million One Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$2,170,000.00) is hereby provided for scholarships for the Rural Physicians Scholarship Program as described in House Bill 1465, 2007 Regular Session. Of this amount, Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) is provided for a Psychiatrist Scholarship as described in Senate Bill 2524, 2019 Regular Session.

83 SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of 84 this act, Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-eight 85 Dollars (\$280,848.00) is provided for the administration of the 86 Rural Physicians Scholarship Program and the Rural Dentists 87 Scholarship Program.

SECTION 13. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2 of this act, One Million Three Hundred Eighty-two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$1,382,250.00) is provided for the Office of Mississippi Physician Workforce as described in House Bill 317, 2012 Regular Session.

It is the intention of the Legislature that 94 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 95 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 96 97 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 98 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 99 100 made without competitive bids.

101 SECTION 15. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1 and 2 of this act, Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand 102 103 Dollars (\$750,000.00) shall be derived from the State General Fund 104 and Four Million Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars 105 (\$4,250,000.00) shall be derived from any special source funds 106 collected by or otherwise become available for the support and 107 maintenance of the University of Mississippi Medical Center for 108 the University of Mississippi Medical Center Cancer Institute.

109 SECTION 16. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this 110 act, Five Hundred Ninety-five Thousand Dollars (\$595,000.00) is 111 hereby appropriated for A Comprehensive Tobacco (ACT) Center at 112 the University of Mississippi Medical Center.

113 SECTION 17. None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized 114 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research that 115 kills or destroys an existing human embryo.

SECTION 18. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
of Section 1 of this act, One Million Three Hundred Forty-nine

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Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-eight Dollars (\$1,349,998.00) shall be provided from General Funds and shall be provided to the Center of Excellence at the Blair E. Batson Hospital for Children for the care of abused and neglected children, and expended to improve, enlarge and/or construct the physical facilities of the Children's Safe Center and for support and maintenance of the center.

SECTION 19. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 20. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 of this act, Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be provided to the MIND Center at the University of Mississippi Medical Center.

SECTION 21. It is the intention of the Legislature that any cash balances at the Office of Physician Workforce, the Children's Safe Center, and the MIND Center shall only be spent in support of those divisions.

SECTION 22. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) shall be provided for the Child Health and Developmental Promotion (CHDP) Fellowship Program.

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 144 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the University of 145 Mississippi Medical Center for the purpose of reauthorizing the 146 147 expenditure of Capital Expense Funds for the Asylum Hill Project, 148 as authorized in SB 3010, 2022 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024..... 149 150\$ 2,956,902.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section, the amount that may be expended under the authority of this section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds remaining as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

157 SECTION 24. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 158 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 159 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 160 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 161 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 162 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 163 SECTION 25. This act shall take effect and be in force from 164 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed from and after

165 June 30, 2023.

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
