1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD AND THE MISSISSIPPI STATE VETERANS HOMES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
8	defraying the expenses and paying salaries of the State Veterans
9	Affairs Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and
10	ending June 30, 2024\$ 5,476,914.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
13	fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Veterans
14	Affairs Board which is comprised of special source funds collected
15	by or otherwise available to the board, for the support and
16	maintenance of said board for the fiscal year beginning
17	July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024\$ 3,141,619.00.

18	SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
19	Section 1 of this act and authorized for expenditure under the
20	provisions of Section 2 of this act, the following positions are
21	authorized:
22	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
23	Permanent: 39
24	Time-Limited: 25
25	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
26	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
27	Services for Fiscal Year 2025 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2024 funds
28	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
29	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 budget by the Mississippi
30	Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
31	personal services appropriation, which shall be published by the
32	State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board
33	shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll costs
34	based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the
35	agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for
36	Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed the data provided by the
37	Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2024
38	projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions
39	shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception
40	of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.
41	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
42	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or

43	allowable	under	the	terms	set	forth	within	this	act.	The State

- Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 44
- approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 45
- Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 46
- 47 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions

- 49 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 50
- 51 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 52 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 53 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 54 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating 55
- 56 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 57 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 58 Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of
- 59 funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered

- 61 It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the
- 62 funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the
- 63 minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.
- In addition to all other sums herein 64 SECTION 4.
- appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 65
- 66 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the special
- fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Veterans 67

74	SECTION 5. Of the funds authorized for expenditure under the
75	provision of Section 4 of this act, the following positions are
76	authorized:

- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 81 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 83 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 84 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 85 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 87 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 88 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 89 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 90 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 91 Executive Director of the State Veterans Affairs Board has the
- 92 authority to transfer spending authority between and within the

- 93 budgets of the State Veterans Affairs Board and the Mississippi
- 94 State Veterans Homes, in an amount not to exceed twenty-five
- 95 percent (25%) of the authorized budgets in the aggregate. The
- 96 purpose of this authority is to use available cash reserves more
- 97 efficiently. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 98 the State Veterans Affairs Board shall submit written
- 99 justification for the transfer to the Legislative Budget Office
- 100 and the Department of Finance and Administration on or before the
- 101 fifteenth of the month prior to the effective date of the
- 102 transfer.
- 103 **SECTION 7.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 104 Sections 1 and 2 of this act, funds in the amount of Two Hundred
- 105 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) are provided to defray the
- 106 cost of providing care to indigent/low-income Mississippi veterans
- 107 and the nonveteran surviving spouses of Mississippi veterans if
- 108 the surviving spouse was a resident of a state veterans home at
- 109 the time of the veteran's death and who, subsequent to the
- 110 veteran's death, meets the indigent/low-income criteria
- 111 established by the State Veterans Affairs Board in the state
- 112 veterans homes. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 113 provision pertaining to use of indigent/low-income surviving
- 114 spouses be retroactive for any such period, prior to the effective
- 115 date of this act, that a current surviving spouse may have met the
- 116 criteria. This section and its provisions shall be known and
- 117 cited as the "Hilton R. 'Jack' Vance Act of 1997."

118	SECTION 8. The State Veterans Affairs Board shall have
119	continued authority for all actions related to the planning,
120	development, construction, and outfitting of the Mississippi
121	Veterans Memorial Cemeteries, pursuant to Section 35-1-41.
122	SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
123	State Veterans Affairs Board shall maintain complete accounting
124	and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
125	appropriated under the provisions of this act and that such
126	records shall be in the same format and level of details as
127	maintained for Fiscal Year 2023. It is further the intention of
128	the Legislature that the budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall
129	be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
130	and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
131	provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.
132	SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
133	State Veterans Affairs Board and the Mississippi State Veterans
134	Homes are hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds
135	from fund number 3373200000, in an amount not to exceed Five
136	Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), for the purpose of operating the
137	state veterans homes as authorized by law, in accordance with
138	rules and regulations of the Department of Finance and
139	Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of
140	federal funds.
141	SECTION 11. It is the intention of the Legislature that

whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

143 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 144 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 145 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 146 147 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 148 made without competitive bids.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 13. the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
