5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
8	Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority for the
9	purposes enumerated in Section 51-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972,
LO	for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
L1	June 30, 2024\$ 159,994.00
L2	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
L3	necessary, is hereby authorized for expenditure out of any special
L 4	source funds which are collected by or otherwise become available
L5	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
L 6	Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority for the fiscal
L7	year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024

- 24 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 25 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 27 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 28 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 29 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 30 **SECTION 4.** It shall be unlawful for any officer, employee or
- 31 other person whatsoever to use or permit or authorize the use of
- 32 any automobile or any other motor vehicle owned by the State of
- 33 Mississippi or any department, agency or institution thereof for
- 34 any purpose other than upon the official business of the State of
- 35 Mississippi or any agency, department or institution thereof.
- It is the intent of the Legislature that motor vehicles

- 39 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 40 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 41 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 42 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 43 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

- 44 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 45 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- made without competitive bids. 46
- SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 47
- 48 Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway Development Authority shall maintain
- 49 complete accounting and personnel records related to the
- expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 50
- records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 51
- 52 maintained for Fiscal Year 2023. It is further the intention of
- 53 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year
- 54 2025 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee
- 55 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level
- 56 of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request
- 57 process.
- SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 58
- 59 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 60 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 61
- 62 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 63 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 64 actions contrary to this provision.
- 65 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 8.
- 66 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 67 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 68

- 69 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 70 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 71 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 72 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 73 June 30, 2023.
