SENATE BILL NO. 3031

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD 3 OF MASSAGE THERAPY, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
- 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Massage Therapy Fund,
- for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State 8
- 9 Board of Massage Therapy for the fiscal year beginning
- July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 192,736.00. 10
- 11 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- Board of Massage Therapy shall maintain complete accounting and 12
- 13 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 14 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 15
- 16 2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to 17
- 18 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of

- 19 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 20 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 22 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 23 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 24 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 25 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 26 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 27 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 28 made without competitive bids.
- 29 **SECTION 4.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 30 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
- 31 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- 32 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
- 33 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
- 34 in the manner provided by law.
- 35 **SECTION 5.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 36 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed from and after
- 37 June 30, 2023.

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
