SENATE BILL NO. 3033

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD 3 OF EXAMINERS FOR LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS FOR FISCAL YEAR 4 2024. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Examiners 9 for Licensed Professional Counselors, for the purpose of defraying 10 the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 273,865.00. 11 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 13 14 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT: 15 Permanent: 2 Time-Limited: 16 0 17 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 18

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19 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 20 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 25 26 Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Licensed Professional 27 Counselors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel 28 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under 29 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and 30 level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2023. It is further 31 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request 32 for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 33 34 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 35 budget request process.

36 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 37 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 38 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 39 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 40 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 41 42 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 43 made without competitive bids.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 45 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 46 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 47 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 48 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 49 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 50 actions contrary to this provision.

51 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 52 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 53 54 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 56 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 57 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed from and after 58 59 June 30, 2023.
