SENATE BILL NO. 3041 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AUDIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 3 2024. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of 8 9 Audit in making the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and counties as provided by Section 7-7-201 et seq., 10 11 Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 8,889,918.00. 12 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 13 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any special funds in the 15 State Treasury to the credit of the State Department of Audit's 16 special fund account for the purpose of paying salaries and defraying the expenses of the State Department of Audit in making 17 18 the audits and investigations of public offices of the state and

Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 23 this act, the following positions are authorized:

27 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 28 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal 29 Services for Fiscal Year 2025 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2024 funds 30 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are 31 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 budget by the Mississippi 32 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's 33 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board 34 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may 35 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year 2024 that may not be utilized for active Fiscal Year 2023 36 37 Headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that 38 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount 39 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments 40 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee 41 42 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the Mississippi State Personnel Board. 43

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44 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and 45 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to 46 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2024 do 47 48 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. Ιf 49 the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 projected cost exceeds the 50 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the 51 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be 52 essential for the agency.

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 53 54 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or 55 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 56 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 57 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 58 59 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 60 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the appropriated level. 61

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A

SECTION 4. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted performance measures provided below:

113	SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that		
114	whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the		
115	purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things		
116	stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,		
117	quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind		
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118 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 119 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 120 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this act, it is the intention of the Legislature that Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) is provided for the purpose of paying fees for a CPA Review Course for the Office of the State Auditor's employees to be reimbursed over a 12-month period by the employee taking the course.

127 SECTION 7. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 128 State Auditor is hereby authorized to escalate, budget and expend 129 funds from any source made available to comply with the Single 130 Audit Act of 1984 for the purpose of employing staff, paying 131 related expenses, or to engage private accountants, as necessary, to comply with the provisions of the act, in accordance with rules 132 133 and regulations of the Department of Finance and Administration in 134 a manner consistent with the escalation of federal funds.

SECTION 8. No more than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) may be provided to defray expenses incurred by the Office of the State Auditor pursuant to the rules and regulations of the United States Department of Justice Federal Equitable Sharing Program. These funds may only be used for nonbudgeted law enforcement purposes by the Office of the State Auditor.

141 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that the142 State Department of Audit shall maintain complete accounting and

It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 146 147 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to 148 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 149 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 150 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.

151 SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2 of this 152 act, it is the intention of the Legislature that Two Hundred 153 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided for the purpose of the 154 Accountancy Fellowship Program as provided by Section 7-7-204, et 155 seq., Mississippi Code of 1972.

156 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 11. 157 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 158 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 159 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 160 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 161 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 162 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from 163 and after July 1, 2023.

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
