SENATE BILL NO. 3113 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO THE OFFICE OF 2 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY 3 SERVING AS THE FISCAL AGENT, FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF CERTAIN PROGRAMS AND FOR CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE FEES 4 5 FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING UPON PASSAGE AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2024. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be 8 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus 9 State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the 10 Office of Workforce Development, with the Department of Employment Security serving as the fiscal agent, for the purposes of 11 12 defraying the expenses of certain programs and for certain 13 administrative fees for the period beginning upon passage and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 28,000,000.00. 14 15 SECTION 2. (1) Of the money appropriated to the Department of Employment Security under Section 1 of this act, Twenty-five 16 Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) shall be distributed as follows: 17

- 38 (2) Of the money appropriated to the Department of

- 40 Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) shall be for the Accelerate Mississippi
- 41 Physician Residency and Fellowship Start-Up Grant Program created
- 42 in Senate Bill No. 2371, 2023 Regular Session.

- SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section and Section 4 of
 this act, the term "department" means the Department of Employment
 Security.
- The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 46 47 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an 48 individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 49 50 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 51 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 52 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing quidelines, quidance, rules, 53 regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 54 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 55 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 56 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 57 58 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 59 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 60 61 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 62 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the
- 64 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient

Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal

- 65 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit
- 66 requirements.

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- 67 (3) None of the funds appropriated under Section 1 of this 68 act shall be used to pay employee premium payments.
- 69 SECTION 4. As a condition of receiving and expending (1)70 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, receiving 71 entities shall certify to the department, and the department shall 72 certify to the Department of Finance and Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to the department under this 73 74 act complies with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations 75 and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the 76 United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of 77 monies from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds 78 established by ARPA.
- 79 If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 80 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 81 82 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 83 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 84 85 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the 86 guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 87 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 88 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State 89 90 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 91

92	were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or
93	recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or
94	otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the
95	amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to
96	the federal government.

- SECTION 5. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

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
