1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM CAPITAL EXPENSE FUNDS FOR 2 THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING CERTAIN INFRASTRUCTURE EXPENSES OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2024; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Capital Expense 8 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 9 Transportation for the purposes described in this Sections 2, 3 10 and 4, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending 11 June 30, 2024.....\$ 620,000,000.00. 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 13 act, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is 14 appropriated out of any money in the Capital Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Transportation for 15 16 the purpose of defraying the expenses of those certain capacity 17 projects as listed in the MDOT 3-year plan.....\$ 480,000,000.00. 20 appropriated out of any money in the Capital Expense Fund not 21 otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Transportation for 22 the purposes described in Section 65-1-179.1 which is the 23 provision of law that provides for the 2022 Emergency Road and 24 Bridge Fund.....\$ 100,000,000.00.

SECTION 4. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated out of any money in the Capital Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of Transportation for the purposes described in Section 65-1-183 which is the provision of law that provides for the 2022 Infrastructure Match Fund...... 1.....\$ 40,000,000.00.

32 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 33 Mississippi Department of Transportation shall expend such funds 34 appropriated herein as necessary to conduct project planning. 35 Such project planning shall apply to all preliminary engineering, 36 right-of-way acquisition and construction projects of the 37 department and, at a minimum, shall consist of policies for the 38 oversight and management of project cost which:

39 (a) Establish a reasonable cost estimate for each
40 project. For purposes of this provision, projects include
41 preliminary engineering, right-of-way acquisition and
42 construction;

43 (b) Capture and retain the initial project cost44 estimates for comparison with final actual expenditures;

Such personnel shall be responsible for signing 48 any revision, and providing a narrative description of the reasons 49 for approving a revision;

(d) Capture the cost of consultants, engineers,
attorneys, contract appraisers and other technical and
professional contractors used in preliminary engineering,
right-of-way acquisition and construction projects.

54 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 55 the State Treasurer out of any money in the Capital Expense Fund 56 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State 57 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his 58 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or 59 officers, in the manner provided by law.

60 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 61 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.
