SENATE BILL NO. 3152  
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF  
2 PEARL, MISSISSIPPI, TO CONTRIBUTE AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED  
3 \$750,000.00 TO TRUSTMARK PARK; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** (1) The governing authorities of the City of  
6 Pearl, Mississippi, are authorized and empowered, in their  
7 discretion, to contribute an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred  
8 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000.00) from available municipal  
9 funds to the athletic facility known as Trustmark Park, a Minor  
10 League Baseball stadium which is located within the city and which  
11 provides economic development and tourism benefits to the city.

12 (2) This section shall be repealed from and after December  
13 31, 2035.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
15 and after its passage.
