SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 506

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE 2 2022 PEARL RIVER COMMUNITY COLLEGE "WILDCATS" BASEBALL TEAM FOR 3 WINNING THEIR FIRST-EVER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND HEAD COACH 4 MICHAEL AVALON FOR HIS 200TH CAREER VICTORY.

5 WHEREAS, there is a new champion in NJCAA Division II 6 baseball. After a disheartening loss in game one of the 2022 7 Championship Series, the Pearl River Community College (PRCC) 8 "Wildcats" persisted and won two games in a row to earn their 9 first-ever National Championship; and

10 WHEREAS, PRCC had been on an impressive roll leading up to the championship series. After a record-breaking 45-win season, a 11 12 MACCC Championship, and a Region 23 Championship, it was no surprise that the "Wildcats" were competing for a national title; 13 14 and WHEREAS, in Enid, Oklahoma, where the Championship Series 15 took place, PRCC lost its first game to No. 2 nationally ranked 16 17 Madison College. Fortunately, the "Wildcats" did not surrender

18 the championship. Following a dominant victory in game two, the

19 "Wildcats" donned their all-gold uniforms for game three.

20 Subsequently, the gold attire was a good luck charm for PRCC as 21 they defeated Madison College 7-2 to take home the Title of 22 National Champions; and

23 WHEREAS, "They didn't make it easy for sure. That's the way 24 we wanted it and that's the way we prepared all year. We were 25 down early and these guys never quit. What a special group," Head 26 Coach Michael Avalon said. "This is the best program in the 27 country. This is the best community college in the country. I'm 28 just thankful and blessed to be a part of it and be at Pearl 29 River"; and

30 WHEREAS, the victory marked the 200th career win for Michael 31 Avalon as a head coach; and

32 WHEREAS, "This is just a remarkable team and a remarkable 33 coaching staff", PRCC President Dr. Adam Breerwood proudly said; 34 and

35 WHEREAS, additional merits were earned after the 36 championship. Gulfport's D.K Donaldson was awarded the National Junior College Athletic Association Division II tournament's "Most 37 38 Valuable Player Award." Tate Parker, also from Gulfport, was 39 given the "Outstanding Offensive Player Award." John Griffen Bell 40 of Mobile, Alabama, was granted the "Outstanding Defensive Player Award," and the "Coach of the Tournament" Award was given to none 41 other than Coach Michael Avalon; and 42
