- 23 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed

- of Representatives and the Mississippi Senate to two (2)
- 26 successive terms. A person may be elected again to the other
- 27 house for two (2) more terms, but shall not serve more than a
- 28 total of sixteen (16) years between the two (2) houses."
