SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 14

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE MISSISSIPPI 2 FILM OFFICE ON THE OCCASION OF ITS 50TH ANNIVERSARY AND 3 RECOGNIZING ITS CONTRIBUTIONS TO MISSISSIPPI'S ECONOMY AND 4 TOURISM.

5 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Film Commission was created on 6 January 17, 1973; and

7 WHEREAS, the significance of the film industry resulted in 8 the promotion of that commission to the Mississippi Film Office as 9 part of the Mississippi Department of Economic Development in 1980 10 allowing the work of that office to provide a public relations 11 impact on global awareness of Mississippi as a tourism and 12 professional destination; and

13 WHEREAS, the film industry, extending back to 1916, has been 14 a significant measure of Mississippi's global reputation, with the Mississippi Film Office expanding that impact beginning with the 15 film Thieves Like Us in 1973, and today having supported the 16 17 production of more than 200 feature films, 29 television movies, 65 documentaries, 25 television series, along with countless 18 19 individual episodes of television programs, short films, N1/2 S. 20 commercial productions, and music videos in Mississippi under the 21 leadership of Directors Walterine Odom, John Horhn, Ward Emling 22 and Nina Parikh; and

23 WHEREAS, the remarkable list of Mississippi authors and 24 literary artists such as Larry Brown, William Faulkner, John 25 Grisham, Beth Henley, Willie Morris, Thomas Hal Phillips, Kathryn Stockett, Eudora Welty and Tennessee Williams have allowed film 26 27 and television productions to highlight Mississippi's 28 contributions to the arts, history, literature, medicine and STEM, 29 along with the legacy of noteworthy public figures such as David 30 Sheffield, Fannie Lou Hamer, Cassandra Wilson, Jessie Mae Hemphill, Medger Evers, Emmett Till, James Meredith, Beah 31 32 Richards, Mamie Till, Robert Johnson, Dr. James Hardy and Elvis Preslev; and 33

34 WHEREAS, with the support of the Mississippi Film Office, 35 local communities, venues, and the natural beauty of the Magnolia 36 State have served as film locations from historic Natchez to the 37 farmlands of the Delta, from the capital city of Jackson to the 38 beaches and casinos of the Gulf Coast, from the town square of 39 Oxford to Meridian, affectionately the railroad town Queen City; 40 and

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Film Office is a key resource for film productions to take advantage of the Mississippi Motion Picture Incentive Program, a state initiative that provides a cash rebate for spending on completed projects that have invested a

WHEREAS, film production in Mississippi has accounted for more than \$575 million in direct expenditure since the creation of the Film Office, along with associated payments to local vendors and professionals; and
