SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 32

1 A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE RECOGNITION AND COMMENDATION OF 2 THE MISSISSIPPI SENATE TO 16-YEAR-OLD CORION EVANS FROM MOSS POINT, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS EXTREME BRAVERY IN RESCUING FOUR 3 4 PEOPLE FROM DROWNING IN A SERIOUS CAR ACCIDENT ON JULY 3, 2022. 5 WHEREAS, Corion Evans, a sixteen-year-old from Moss Point, Mississippi, is being hailed as both a state and national hero 6 7 after he rescued four people from drowning on July 3, 2022; and 8 WHEREAS, at 2:30 a.m. a car, which had three teenage girls 9 inside, was accidentally driven off of a boat launch and plunged 10 into the dark, alligator-infested waters of the Pascagoula River; 11 and 12 WHEREAS, without a thought for his own safety, Evans dove into the water and began rescuing the young women one at a time. 13

Afterwards, Evans explained that he thought of nothing but getting the victims to shore and was determined not to let anyone die that night; and

17 WHEREAS, Evans not only saved the young women, he also saved 18 the life of Police Officer Garry Mercer, who had responded to the

19 scene. Dragged underwater by a panicked victim, Mercer began 20 drowning himself, but was brought safely to shore by Evans; and

21 WHEREAS, Moss Point Police Chief Brandon Ashley commended 22 Evans for the "bravery and selflessness he displayed by risking 23 his own safety to help people in danger"; and

24 WHEREAS, Evans was awarded certificates of commendation from 25 the city. Mayor Billy Knight of Moss Point declared: "We are 26 proud of the young man for having the courage to forget about 27 himself and jump into the water. It's not often enough that you 28 see people put others above themselves"; and

29 WHEREAS, Corion Evans serves as a reminder of the heroic, 30 selfless individuals who reside in Mississippi. He has honored 31 his fellow citizens with the pride and prestige he has brought to 32 our state:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby extend the recognition and commendation of the Mississippi Senate to 16-year-old Corion Evans from Moss Point, Mississippi, for his extreme bravery in rescuing four people from drowning in a serious car accident on July 3, 2022, and extend our sincerest wishes for success in his future endeavors.

40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to 41 Corion Evans and his family, forwarded to the Mayor and Board of 42 Aldermen of Moss Point and made available to the Capitol Press 43 Corps.
