1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE LAMAR SCHOOL
2 "RAIDERS" GIRLS VOLLEYBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH COURTNEY
3 SCHIMELPFENING FOR WINNING THEIR FIRST MAIS 5A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP.

4 WHEREAS, we join the students, coaches, parents and faculty
5 at Lamar School in Meridian, Mississippi, in celebrating the
6 "Raiders" girls volleyball team's first MAIS 5A State Championship
7 in program history; and

8 WHEREAS, on October 19, 2022, the Lamar School "Raiders"
9 swept Simpson Academy in three sets to win the MAIS 5A State
10 Championship at Mississippi College; and

11 WHEREAS, Lamar School earned first-round bye in the start of

13 State Championship for the second year in a row; and
