- WHEREAS, Brookhaven Academy "Lady Cougars" Basketball Team
- 5 posed with the 2023 MAIS 5A Girls Basketball Championship Banner
- 6 after defeating Leake Academy. They are now going for the MAIS
- 7 Overall Tournament Championship; and
- 8 WHEREAS, as the season progressed, and the wins piled up, and
- 9 the losses became few and far between, there was a feeling among
- 10 the parents, fans and supporters of the Brookhaven Academy Girls
- 11 Basketball Team that the squad they were watching was the best in
- 12 MAIS 5A Basketball; and
- WHEREAS, on February 18, 2023, in Greenwood, Brookhaven
- 14 Academy (39-3) showed that belief was well-founded by beating
- 15 Leake Academy 42-36 in the MAIS 5A State Tournament Championship
- 16 Game; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the 2023 team that Brookhaven Academy Coach Ron

18 Kessler assembled is one that has grown in confidence throughout

- 19 the season as the starting lineup of two seniors, one junior, one
- 20 sophomore and an eighth-grader kept improving; and
- 21 WHEREAS, with Pillow Academy's recently refurbished Stribling
- 22 Gymnasium packed with fans from both Championship-rich programs,
- 23 nerves were high in the early going of the Championship Game. The
- 24 "Lady Cougars" had a size advantage, but Leake is a team that
- 25 rebounds the ball well offensively as the guards on the team chase
- 26 down long misses before the opposing post players could respond.
- 27 Not letting Leake get hot from deep and not allowing the pace of
- 28 the game to slip from its control was one of the main goals for
- 29 Coach Kessler and his team; and
- 30 WHEREAS, with just under 60 seconds left until halftime,
- 31 Fortenberry got open on the wing when her defender got caught up
- 32 by Lillie Gates posting up in the paint. With 41 seconds left,
- 33 the "Lady Cougars" had the game won. Leake got two looks from the
- 34 three-point line to try and tie, but both shots missed, and
- 35 Brookhaven Academy made 3-of-4 free throws late to ice the win.
- 36 For the game, Leake finished 9-of-38 from the three-point line.
- 37 Brookhaven Academy went 4-of-17 from the three-point line and
- 38 12-of-18 from the free-throw line; and
- 39 WHEREAS, in the Semifinal Game, Coach Ron Kessler knew the
- 40 assignment was difficult. He and his "Lady Cougars" had to come
- 41 into Pillow Academy's newly renovated gym, home of one of the
- 42 winningest girls basketball programs in Mississippi history, and
- 43 face a talented and physical team coached by the third-winningest

- 44 active girls basketball coach in the country. Brookhaven passed
- 45 the test with a 59-49 victory over Pillow on February 17, 2023, in
- 46 the MAIS Class 5A State Semifinals in Greenwood; and
- 47 WHEREAS, the 2023 Brookhaven Academy "Lady Cougars"
- 48 Championship Roster is: Reagan Fortenberry, Mallory Martin, Ella
- 49 Brown, Anne Rylea Thurman, Izzy Nelson, Braelynn Byrd, Ainsley
- 50 Orr, Ella Smith, Matti Clair Smith, Lillie Gates, Chloe Nelson,
- 51 Kyla Armistad, Ava Calcote and Emma Gates; Head Coach Ron Kessler
- 52 and Assistant Coach Hugh Webb; and
