SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 72

20 she plans to volunteer for them in the future; and

23 Mississippi High School Activities Association Class 4A State
24 Soccer Championship in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2021; and

26 this outstanding Mississippian whose hard work and zealous
27 dedication to her team and the State Games have brought honor to
28 the Meridian community and to the State of Mississippi:
