- 1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE LAKE HIGH
- 2 SCHOOL "LADY HORNETS" GIRLS BASKETBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH HOLLY
- 3 MONCRIEF FOR WINNING BACK-TO-BACK MHSAA CLASS 2A STATE
- 4 CHAMPIONSHIPS WHICH IS THE FOURTH STATE TITLE IN SCHOOL HISTORY.
- 5 WHEREAS, behind the stellar play of Laneisha Palm along with
- 6 second half defense Lake High School "Lady Hornets" Girls
- 7 Basketball Team ran past Heidelberg 67-48 to claim the MHSAA Girls
- 8 Class 2A State Championship for the second consecutive year at the
- 9 Mississippi Coliseum on March 3, 2023; and
- 10 WHEREAS, it's the "Lady Hornets" (24-9) fourth State Title in
- 11 school history; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "Something we talked about at the beginning is to
- 13 set the tempo and take control of the game for the whole game,"
- 14 said first-year Lake Coach Holly Moncrief. "That's exactly what
- 15 they did. I can't say enough about the girls, I'm so proud of
- 16 them"; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the "Lady Hornets" never trailed, jumped out to an
- 18 8-3 lead, and Taylor Clark banked in a three-pointer at the buzzer
- 19 to give Lake a 13-4 lead at the end of the first quarter.

- 20 Heidelberg began the second quarter on an 8-4 run to cut the "Lady
- 21 Hornets" lead down to 17-13; however, the "Lady Hornets" ended the
- 22 first half on a 10-4 run to take a 29-19 advantage at halftime;
- 23 and
- 24 WHEREAS, in the second half, Palm took over for Lake. The
- 25 multisport athlete scored 10 of the "Lady Hornets" 17 points in
- 26 the third quarter, and Lake held a 46-31 lead heading into the
- 27 fourth quarter. Palm was named the game's Most Valuable Player.
- 28 She finished 14-of-20 from the floor, tying the number of baskets
- 29 the entire Heidelberg Team made that afternoon; and
- 30 WHEREAS, the Lake High School "Lady Hornets" Girls Basketball

- 39 student athletes who have again brought honor to their school,
- 40 their community and to the State of Mississippi:

- 42 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate the Lake
- 43 High School "Lady Hornets" Girls Basketball Team and Head Coach
- 44 Holly Moncrief for winning back-to-back MHSAA Class 2A State

- 45 Championships which is the fourth State Title in school history,
- 46 and extend to the team, coaches, parents and sponsors our best
- 47 wishes for future success.
