## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2556

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5 SECTION 1. Section 49-1-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows:

7 49-1-15. (1) All appointments of conservation officers
8 shall be under rules adopted and promulgated by the commission.
9 No person shall be appointed from and after July 1, 2001, unless
10 he meets the following requirements:

(a) Is at least twenty-one (21) years of age; and

(b) Has successfully completed sixty-four (64) semester hours at an accredited community college or university or has an associate degree from an accredited community college or has passed the Law Enforcement Academy and has at least \* \* \* <u>two (2)</u> years experience in law enforcement.

17 (2) Each applicant, prior to entering into performance of 18 his duties, at the expense of the department, shall attend and 19 complete an appropriate curriculum in the field of law enforcement 20 at the Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers' Training Academy or 21 other training academy whose curriculum complies with requirements S. B. 2556 PAGE 1 of the Board on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training.
Conservation officers shall, on a periodic basis, be required to
successfully complete additional advanced courses in law
enforcement in order that they will be properly improved and
trained in the modern, technical advances of law enforcement.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-1-15, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 CLARIFY QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT AS A CONSERVATION OFFICER; 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
