House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2575

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 83-9-10, Mississippi Code of 1972:

19 <u>83-9-10.</u> (1) For purposes of this section, the terms
20 "alternative delivery systems" and "covered benefits" shall have
21 the same definitions as provided in Section 83-9-37.

(2) All alternative delivery systems and all group health
insurance policies, plans or programs regulated by the State of
Mississippi shall provide covered benefits for medical treatment
provided by the county health departments of the State Department
of Health in the same manner as other providers.

(3) Alternative delivery systems and group health insurance
policies, plans or programs regulated by the State of Mississippi
shall not deny the State Department of Health the right to
participate as a contract provider.

31 (4) Nothing in this section shall prohibit alternative 32 delivery systems and group health insurance policies, plans or 33 programs regulated by the State of Mississippi from being able to S. B. 2575 PAGE 1 34 negotiate an appropriate fee schedule for medical treatment

37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
