THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for expenses of the
9	Executive Department, being the Governor's Office and staff, and
10	for expenses incidental to the proper operation of the Governor's
11	Mansion and residence of the Governor for the fiscal year
12	beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024
13	\$ 2,745,438.00.
14	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
15	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in Special
16	Funds in the State Treasury to the credit of the Governor's Office
17	for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred by the
18	Executive Department, being the Governor's Office and staff, for
19	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024

S. B. 3044 PAGE 1 21 SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 22 Sections 1 and 2 of this act, the following positions are 23 authorized:

24 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:

25 Permanent: 39

26 Time-Limited: 7

Any escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms,conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 33 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 34 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 35 36 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 37 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 38 39 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 40 made without competitive bids.

41 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 42 Executive Department shall maintain complete accounting and 43 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 44 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 45 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 46 2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 5. B. 3044 PAGE 2 47 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to 48 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 49 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 50 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.

51 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 52 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 53 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 54 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 56 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 57 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from

58 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed from and after 59 June 29, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EXPENSES OF THE EXECUTIVE 2 DEPARTMENT, BEING THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE AND STAFF, AND FOR 3 EXPENSES INCIDENTAL TO THE PROPER OPERATION OF THE GOVERNOR'S 4 MANSION AND RESIDENCE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024.
