260	(10) (a) After a determination by the court of the amount
261	due, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly
262	collect all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this

section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of this section may not be paid by personal check.

- 265 It shall be the duty of the chancery clerk of each 266 county to deposit all state assessments collected in the circuit, 267 county and justice courts in the county on a monthly basis with 268 the State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established 269 by the State Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly 270 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 271 circuit, county and justice courts in the county under this 272 section, and shall report to the Department of Finance and 273 Administration the total number of violations under each 274 subsection for which state assessments were collected in the 275 circuit, county and justice courts in the county during that 276 month.
- 277 It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each 278 municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the 279 municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the 280 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by 281 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly 282 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the 283 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall 284 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total 285 number of violations under each subsection for which state 286 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the 287 municipality during that month.

288	(11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and
289	Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments
290	into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State
291	Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall
292	issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these
293	funds.

(12) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund. All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with the procedures established by the Auditor."
