AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Cmte Sub for House Bill No. 1207

1 **Amend** on line 74 by inserting after "SECTION 5.", the
2 following: "(1)"

3 **Further, amend** after line 100, by inserting the following:

4 "(2) The Office of Workforce Development is authorized to
5 enter into a memorandum of agreement with any public or nonpublic
6 school which provides secondary education to students enrolled
7 therein, for the purpose of allowing students who are at least
8 seventeen (17) years of age to be eligible for enrollment in any
9 accredited paramedic training program without any cost to the
10 students, through a dual-credit or dual-enrollment class offerings
11 through an accredited entity authorized by the office to provide
12 such trainings for purposes of the program. However, such
13 students shall not be eligible to take any examination for
14 certification as a paramedic until the time that he or she attains



15 the age of eighteen (18), at which time he or she would be allowed
16 to take the certification examination to become a certified
17 Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)."

18 **Further, amend the title to conform.**
