- 17 Influence or affect, by intimidation or

- (b) It is not a defense to a prosecution under this 21
- 22 section that, at the time the defendant made the terroristic
- 23 threat, the defendant did not have the intent or capability to
- 24 actually commit the specified offense, nor is it a defense that
- 25 the threat was not made to a person who was a subject or intended
- victim of the threatened act. 26
- 27 A person convicted of the offense of making a
- terroristic threat is quilty of a felony punishable by 28
- 29 imprisonment in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
- 30 Corrections for not more than ten (10) years.
