AMENDMENT NO 1 TO AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

Senate Bill No. 2523

1 **Amend** on line 19 by striking "brough forward" and inserting
2 in lieu thereof: "amended".

3 **Further, amend** on line 31 by inserting the following after
4 the period:

5 "Any person found to be in violation of this section shall be
6 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined an
7 amount not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or be
8 imprisoned for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days in jail, or
9 both such fine and imprisonment."

10 **Further, amend** on line 52 by inserting after the word "who",
11 the following:

12 ", without the owner's permission, enters upon the private
13 property of an owner of lands upon which pecan trees are growing
14 for the purpose of removing pecans from the premises thereof,
15 whether from the grounds or within any facility thereon where the



16 pecans are stored, for his or her own financial benefit which
17 causes financial detriment and other damages or hardships to the
18 owner of the pecan trees,".

19 **Further, amend** on line 61 by inserting after the period, the
20 following:

21 "Whether the felonious crime is prosecuted as petit larceny or
22 grand larceny shall be determined by the amount of the pecan's
23 fair market value at the time the theft of the pecans occurred."

24 **Further, amend** on line 63 by striking ", and shall stand
25 repealed on June 30, 2023".

26 **Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety,** and
27 inserting in lieu thereof:

28 "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 69-33-1, 639-33-3 AND 69-33-9,
29 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE CRIMINAL AND CIVIL
30 PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THE PROVISIONS OF THE PECAN HARVESTING
31 LAW; TO BRING FORWARD SECTIONS 69-33-5 AND 69-33-7, MISSISSIPPI
32 CODE OF 1972, FOR THE PURPOSE OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENTS; AND FOR
33 RELATED PURPOSES."
