It is the intention of the Legislature that the 42 Executive Department shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 43 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 44 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 45 46 2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to 47 48 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 49 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 50 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.

51 **SECTION 6.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 52 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 53 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 54 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 56 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 57 SECTION 7.
