## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 266

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

9	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The Mississippi State Crime Laboratory of the
10	Mississippi Department of Public Safety located in Pearl, Rankin
11	County, Mississippi, shall be named the "Tom Weathersby State
12	Crime Laboratory" <u>upon the retirement of Tom Weathersby from the</u>
13	Mississippi Legislature. The Department of Finance and
14	Administration shall prepare or have prepared a distinctive
15	plaque, to be approved by the Mississippi Department of Public
16	Safety and the Mississippi House of Representatives, to be placed
17	in a prominent place within the building, that states the
18	background, accomplishments and service to the state by the
19	Honorable Tom Weathersby. The Department of Finance and
20	Administration, in conjunction with the Mississippi Department of
21	Public Safety, shall erect or cause to be erected proper lettering
22	or signage on the outdoor facade of the building displaying the
23	official name of the building as the "Tom Weathersby State Crime
24	Laboratory." Any and all funds necessary to accomplish this act
25	will be appropriated by the Legislature for such purpose.

26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO NAME THE MISSISSIPPI STATE CRIME LABORATORY IN
PEARL, RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, THE "TOM WEATHERSBY STATE CRIME
LABORATORY"; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
TO ERECT THE PROPER LETTERING OR SIGNAGE ON THE OUTDOOR FACADE OF
THE BUILDING DISPLAYING THE OFFICIAL NAME AS THE "TOM WEATHERSBY
STATE CRIME LABORATORY"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
