Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 557

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-146-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-146-7. Identification and recruitment of undergraduate
- 9 participants; designation of underserved or rural area; applicant
- 10 qualifications; maximum number of new admissions per year. (1)
- 11 The commission shall develop and implement policies and procedures
- 12 designed to recruit, identify and enroll undergraduate students
- 13 who demonstrate necessary interest, commitment, aptitude and
- 14 academic achievement to pursue careers as dentists in rural or
- 15 dentally underserved areas of Mississippi, and to develop and
- 16 implement the programs designed to foster successful entry of
- 17 participants into dental school, completion of dental school, and
- 18 establishment and maintenance of a career in dentistry in a rural
- 19 or underserved area of Mississippi.
- 20 (2) The commission shall have the authority through use of
- 21 generally applicable definitions, to designate an area of the
- 22 state as underserved or rural.

- 23 (3) The commission, in conjunction with the University of
- 24 Mississippi Medical Center, shall have the authority to provide
- 25 students selected for scholarship funding with faculty mentors and
- 26 other programs designed to enhance the students' likelihood of
- 27 admission to the dental school. The commission and the University
- 28 of Mississippi Medical Center will develop coursework that will
- 29 help provide scholarship students with the skills necessary for
- 30 sustained and successful dental practice in rural Mississippi.
- 31 (4) Each applicant for admission to the program must submit
- 32 an application to the commission that conforms to requirements
- 33 established by the commission.
- 34 (5) In selecting participants for the program, the board may
- 35 only accept an applicant if his or her academic record and other
- 36 characteristics, if given consideration by the University of
- 37 Mississippi School of Dentistry Admissions Committee, would be
- 38 considered credible and competitive.
- 39 (6) An applicant for the program may be admitted only upon a
- 40 majority vote of the members of the commission.
- 41 (7) Up to \star \star six (6) students will be admitted to the
- 42 Mississippi Rural Dentists Scholarship Program each year.
- 43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-146-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS ADMITTED ANNUALLY TO THE

- 3 MISSISSIPPI RURAL DENTIST SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FROM THREE TO SIX;
- 4 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
