## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 799

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 47-5-933, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 47-5-933. The Department of Corrections may contract for the
- 9 purposes set out in Section 47-5-931 for a period of not more than
- 10 twenty (20) years. The contract may provide that the Department
- of Corrections pay a fee of no more than \* \* \* Thirty-four Dollars
- 12 (\$34.00) per day for each offender that is housed in the facility.
- 13 The Department of Corrections may include in the contract, as an
- 14 inflation factor, a three percent (3%) annual increase in the
- 15 contract price. The state shall retain responsibility for medical
- 16 care for state offenders to the extent that is required by law;
- 17 provided, however, the department may reimburse each facility for
- 18 contract medical services as provided by law in an amount not to
- 19 exceed Six Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$6.25) per day per
- 20 offender.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 47-5-933, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO INCREASE FROM \$31.00 TO \$34.00 THE AMOUNT THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS PAYS PER DAY FOR EACH STATE OFFENDER WHO IS HOUSED IN A REGIONAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
