## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 917

## TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 29-5-2, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 29-5-2. The duties of the Department of Finance and
- 9 Administration shall be as follows:
- 10 (a) (i) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 11 and keep in good condition the following state property located in
- 12 the City of Jackson: the New State Capitol Building, the Woolfolk
- 13 State Office Building and Parking Garage, the Carroll Gartin
- 14 Justice Building, the Walter Sillers Office Building and Parking
- 15 Garage, the War Veterans' Memorial Building, the Charlotte Capers
- 16 Building, the William F. Winter Archives and History Building, the
- 17 Mississippi Museum Complex, the Gulf, Mobile and Ohio Train Depot
- 18 (GM&O Depot), the Old State Capitol Building, the Governor's
- 19 Mansion, the Heber Ladner Building, the Robert E. Lee Office
- 20 Building, the Robert E. Lee Parking Garage, the former Naval
- 21 Reserve Center, 515 East Amite Street, 620 North Street, 660 North
- 22 Street, 700 North State Street, 350 High Street, 401 North Lamar

- 23 Street, 455 North Lamar Street, the State Records Center, the
- 24 Robert G. Clark, Jr. Building, the Mississippi State Fairgrounds
- 25 Complex, the former Central High Building, the Mississippi
- 26 Workers' Compensation Commission Office Building, as well as all
- 27 state-owned or leased buildings situated on seat of government
- 28 property.
- 29 (ii) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 30 and keep in good condition the Dr. Eldon Langston Bolton Building
- 31 located in Biloxi, Mississippi.
- 32 (iii) To exercise general supervision and care
- 33 over and keep in good condition the State Service Center, located
- 34 at the intersection of U.S. Highway 49 and John Merl Tatum
- 35 Industrial Drive in Hattiesburg, Mississippi.
- 36 (iv) To exercise general supervision and care over
- 37 and keep in good condition any property purchased, constructed or
- 38 otherwise acquired by the State of Mississippi for conducting
- 39 state business and not specifically under the supervision and care
- 40 by any other state entity, but which is reasonably assumed the
- 41 department would be responsible for such, as approved by the
- 42 Public Procurement Review Board, including, but not limited to:
- 43 1. The National Aeronautics and Space
- 44 Administration (NASA) Shared Services Center and Lockheed Martin
- 45 Building at Stennis Space Center;
- 46 2. The Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame;
- 47 3. The Mississippi Crafts Center;
- 48 4. The Mississippi Children's Museum; and

5. The Mississippi Arts and Entertainment

- 51 To assign suitable office space for the various state departments, officers and employees who are provided with an 52 53 office in any of the buildings under the jurisdiction or control 54 of the Department of Finance and Administration. However, the assignment of space in the New Capitol Building shall be 55 56 designated by duly passed resolution of the combined Senate Rules 57 Committee and the House Management Committee, meeting as a joint 58 committee, approved by the Lieutenant Governor and Speaker of the 59 House of Representatives. A majority vote of the members of the 60 Senate Rules Committee and a majority vote of the members of the 61 House Management Committee shall be required on all actions taken, 62 resolutions or reports adopted, and all other matters considered by the full combined committee on occasions when the Senate Rules 63 64 Committee and the House Management Committee shall meet as a full
- 66 To approve or disapprove with the concurrence of 67 the Public Procurement Review Board, any lease or rental 68 agreements by any state agency or department, including any state 69 agency financed entirely by federal and special funds, for space 70 outside the buildings under the jurisdiction of the Department of 71 Finance and Administration, including space necessary for parking 72 to be used by state employees who work in the Woolfolk Building, 73 the Carroll Gartin Justice Building or the Walter Sillers Office 74 Building. In no event shall any employee, officer, department,

- 75 federally funded agency or bureau of the state be authorized to
- 76 enter into a lease or rental agreement without prior approval of
- 77 the Department of Finance and Administration and the Public
- 78 Procurement Review Board.
- 79 The Department of Finance and Administration is authorized to
- 80 use architects, engineers, building inspectors and other personnel
- 81 for the purpose of making inspections as may be deemed necessary
- 82 in carrying out its duties and maintaining the facilities.
- This section is not intended to apply to locations for which
- 84 the Department of Finance and Administration has decided to
- 85 solicit proposals in accordance with subsection (e) of this
- 86 section.
- 87 (d) To acquire by lease, lease-purchase agreement, or
- 88 otherwise, as provided in Section 27-104-107, and to assign
- 89 through the Office of General Services, by lease or sublease
- 90 agreement from the office, and with the concurrence of the Public
- 91 Procurement Review Board, to any state agency or department,
- 92 including any state agency financed entirely by federal and
- 93 special funds, appropriate office space in the buildings acquired.
- 94 (e) To solicit and approve or disapprove,
- 95 notwithstanding any rule of law to the contrary, and with the
- 96 concurrence of the Public Procurement Review Board, any lease, use
- 97 or rental agreement for a charge or other consideration for space
- 98 not exceeding three thousand (3,000) square feet in any individual
- 99 building listed in subsection (a) of this section, with a private

- entry who will provide food and/or catering services for state employees, visitors and the general public.
- The department shall select the entity using a competitive process which shall be publicly advertised. In addition to satisfying any other requirements for the Public Procurement Review Board's approval, the department must demonstrate that any agreement entered into under this section will neither result in a net cost to the state, nor impair or impede the function of state agencies at such location.
- 109 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 110 and after July 1, 2023.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 29-5-2, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PLACE THE MISSISSIPPI WORKERS' COMPENSATION COMMISSION OFFICE BUILDING UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND CARE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
