Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1048

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 13 **SECTION 1.** This act shall be known and cited as the
- 14 "Universal Changing Tables Installation Incentive Grant Program
- 15 Act."
- 16 **SECTION 2.** (1) There is established the Universal Changing
- 17 Tables Installation Incentive Grant Program for the purpose and
- 18 intent of providing financial assistance to public entities
- 19 located within the State of Mississippi to install universal
- 20 changing tables in one or more restrooms in existing or proposed
- 21 facilities under its control.
- 22 (2) Any state agency, department, municipal or county
- 23 governing authority exercising ownership and control over any
- 24 public facility which is accessible to the public, may be entitled
- 25 to receive grants up to a maximum amount of Five Thousand Dollars
- 26 (\$5,000.00) for each universal changing table installed in one or
- 27 more restrooms in existing or proposed facilities under its
- 28 control. Based upon a determination by the Mississippi Department
- 29 of Rehabilitation Services, relative to the funds made available

- 30 for the awarding of grants for the purpose specified in this act,
- 31 the department may increase or decrease the number of grants
- 32 awarded accordingly under the authority prescribed in Section 3 of
- 33 this act.
- 34 (3) Grants shall be funded from monies appropriated by the
- 35 Legislature to the department for that purpose, or any other
- 36 source of funding made available to the department for purposes of
- 37 this act. Grants shall be awarded on the basis of available funds
- 38 on a first-come, first-served basis, provided that grant
- 39 applicants satisfy the criteria established by the department for
- 40 the awarding of grants.
- 41 (4) To cover the costs of administering the grant program in
- 42 accordance with this act, the Department of Rehabilitation
- 43 Services may receive up to one percent (1%) of any appropriation
- 44 received by the department for the awarding of grants.
- 45 **SECTION 3.** (1) The Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation
- 46 Services shall administer the Universal Changing Tables
- 47 Installation Incentive Grant Program and shall have the following
- 48 powers and duties:
- 49 (a) Receiving applications for grants under the grant
- 50 program;
- 51 (b) Determining the eligibility of applicants and
- 52 paying the grants from any funds available;
- 53 (c) Adopting and enforcing appropriate rules and
- 54 regulations regarding forms designed to be used by applicants for
- 55 grants and the eligibility of applicants;

- 56 (d) Developing criteria for evaluating the growing need
- 57 for the installation of universal changing tables, including, but
- 58 not be limited to:
- 59 (i) The percentage of the state's population
- 60 living with a physical disability; and
- 61 (ii) The number of existing public facilities
- 62 currently equipped with a universal changing table;
- (e) Developing the administrative policy for the grant
- 64 program;
- (f) Promulgating rules and regulations pertaining to
- 66 the implementation and operation of the grant program;
- 67 (g) Establishing a budget to support the activities of
- 68 the program and periodically reviewing and, if appropriate,
- 69 revising, the amount of the grants offered through the program;
- 70 (h) Any other rules and regulations as the department
- 71 may deem necessary or appropriate to carry out the purposes and
- 72 intent of the grant program; and
- 73 (i) Collaborating with the Department of Archives and
- 74 History and the Department of Finance and Administration to ensure
- 75 that the integrity of facilities designated as historic landmarks
- 76 is not compromised by the installation of a universal changing
- 77 table within such facilities.
- 78 (2) When reviewing applications for grant awards, the
- 79 department shall give priority to applicants whose applications
- 80 specify that in the installation of the universal changing table,
- 81 the table is:

- 82 (a) Powered and height-adjustable, for safety of the
- 83 person and caregiver assisting;
- 84 (b) Placed in single occupancy restrooms, universal to
- 85 gender;
- 86 (c) Placed in a room with a minimum size of at least
- 87 ten (10) feet by fourteen and six-tenths (14.6) feet, which allows
- 88 for a turning radius of sixty (60) inches for the wheelchair in
- 89 the middle of the room and thirty-six (36) inches of space at one
- 90 (1) end of the table; and
- 91 (d) Made known to the visitors by the placement of
- 92 clearly visible signage at the entrance of the building.
- 93 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 94 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE UNIVERSAL CHANGING TABLES
INSTALLATION INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM ACT FOR THE PURPOSES OF
CREATING FINANCIAL INCENTIVES TO PUBLIC ENTITIES LOCATED WITHIN

THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO INSTALL UNIVERSAL CHANGING TABLES

- 5 WITHIN THE RESTROOM OF FACILITIES UNDER THEIR CONTROL; TO PROVIDE
- 6 THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION SERVICES SHALL
- 7 ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE THAT GRANTS SHALL BE FUNDED
- 8 FROM MONIES APPROPRIATED BY THE LEGISLATURE AND ANY OTHER SOURCES
- 9 OF FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THAT PURPOSE; TO
- 10 PROVIDE THAT THE GRANTS SHALL BE AWARDED SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE
- 11 FUNDING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
