AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section the following terms
7	shall have the meaning ascribed herein:
8	(a) "Feminine hygiene products" means tampons and
9	sanitary napkins for use in connection with the menstrual cycle.
10	(b) "School building" means any facility:
11	(i) That is owned or leased by the school district
12	or over which the board has care, custody and control; and
13	(ii) In which there is a public school serving
14	students in Grade 6 through Grade 12.
15	(2) School districts are authorized to make feminine hygiene
16	products available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms or
17	offices of the school nurse in school buildings.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
19	and after July 1, 2023.

inserting in lieu thereof the following:
