Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1610

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Any meetings of the Joint 60 Legislative Reapportionment Committee shall be held in state 61 offices or at publicly owned facilities.

SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the monthly expense allowance of the members of the Legislature, as provided in Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, as follows:

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 For the House of Representatives.....\$ 2,392,922.00.

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 For the Senate.....\$ 1,039,050.00.

SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the state's share of various assessments for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 448,878.00. Of the funds authorized in this section, the following

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 84 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury 85 to the credit of the joint operations of the House of Representatives and the Senate not otherwise appropriated, for the 86 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024..... 87 88\$ 50,000.00.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 89 90 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this Legislature for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 91 92 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 93 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 94 95 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 96 made without competitive bids.

97 SECTION 6. None of the funds appropriated under the 98 provisions of this act may be used to pay or reimburse any 99 expenses of out-of-state travel for any member or employee of the 100 House of Representatives without prior approval of the House 101 Management Committee or for any member or employee of the Senate 102 without prior approval of the Senate Rules Committee.

SECTION 7. Of the funds provided herein, the Clerk of the Mississippi House of Representatives and the Secretary of the Mississippi Senate may transfer funds between accounts for their H. B. 1610 106 respective chambers which are administered by the Mississippi 107 House of Representatives and the Mississippi Senate.

The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 108 SECTION 8. 109 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 110 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 111 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue warrants upon requisitions signed by the 112 113 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 114 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 115 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
