## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the
8	Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal year
10	beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
11	June 30, 2024\$ 75,945,858.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:

15 Permanent: 39

16 Time-Limited:

17 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

18 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

19 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

20 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this

22 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

23 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the

24 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain

25 complete accounting and personnel records related to the

26 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such

27 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as

28 maintained for Fiscal Year 2023. It is further the intention of

29 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year

30 2025 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee

31 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level

of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request 32

34 It is the intention of the Legislature that SECTION 4.

35 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the

36 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

37 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,

38 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind

shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 39

- 40 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 41 made without competitive bids.
- 42 **SECTION 5.** Of the funds appropriated herein, One Hundred
- 43 Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00) is provided for salary
- 44 increase for the purpose of funding overtime, callback or standby
- 45 pay.
- SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 47 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall only expend
- 48 funds on activities directly related to the operation of the state
- 49 port.
- 50 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 52 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 53 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 54 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 56 actions contrary to this provision.
- 57 **SECTION 8.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 58 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 59 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 60 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2023.
