- 19 557, 603, 604 and 1734, 2023 Regular Session, and Senate Bill
- 20 Numbers 2333, 2335, 2444, 2454, 2465, 2474, 2692 and 2749, 2023
- 21 Regular Session. Appropriation bills are those bills that are
- 22 designated as appropriation bills for the purpose of the deadlines
- 23 imposed by Joint Rule No. 40.
- 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2023 Regular Session of the
- 25 Legislature will stand adjourned Sine Die at 12:00 midnight,
- 26 Tuesday, April 4, 2023.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
