AMENDMENT NO 2 PROPOSED TO**

House Concurrent Resolution No. 60

BY: Senator(s) Harkins, Hopson, Parker

**Amend by striking all after the resolving clause and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

8 That the 2023 Regular Session of the Legislature is extended for a
9 period of thirty (30) days from the final day of the ninety (90)
10 calendar days of the 2023 Regular Session of the Legislature,
11 under the provisions of Section 36, Mississippi Constitution of
12 1890.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all of the deadlines and other
14 provisions imposed by Joint Rule No. 40, are suspended for the
15 purpose of permitting the further consideration, filing and
16 adoption of conference reports, after the deadlines for those
17 actions in Joint Rule No. 40, on any appropriation bills that were



18 in conference on March 27, 2023, and on House Bill Numbers 521,
19 557, 603, 604 and 1734, 2023 Regular Session, and Senate Bill
20 Numbers 2333, 2335, 2444, 2454, 2465, 2474, 2692 and 2749, 2023
21 Regular Session. Appropriation bills are those bills that are
22 designated as appropriation bills for the purpose of the deadlines
23 imposed by Joint Rule No. 40.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the 2023 Regular Session of the
25 Legislature will stand adjourned Sine Die at 12:00 midnight,
26 Tuesday, April 4, 2023.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE 2023 REGULAR SESSION OF
2 THE LEGISLATURE; SUSPENDING THE DEADLINES FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 PERMITTING THE FURTHER CONSIDERATION, FILING AND ADOPTION OF
4 CONFERENCE REPORTS ON CERTAIN APPROPRIATION BILLS AND CERTAIN
5 OTHER BILLS; AND SETTING THE DATE OF SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT OF THE
6 2023 REGULAR SESSION OF THE LEGISLATURE.
