HOUSE BILL NO. 68

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 EXCLUSIVELY RECOGNIZE DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.'S BIRTHDAY ON 3 THE THIRD MONDAY OF JANUARY; TO OBSERVE ROBERT E. LEE'S BIRTHDAY 4 ON THE SAME DAY AS CONFEDERATE MEMORIAL DAY; TO REMOVE CONFEDERATE 5 MEMORIAL DAY AS A LEGAL STATE HOLIDAY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Legislature desires to reflect the 7 transformative power of Mississippi from its past to its present 8 by celebrating holidays that wholly reflect the remarkable strides 9 made by all citizens; NOW, THEREFORE, 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 12 amended as follows: 3-3-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) 13 14 of this section, the following are declared to be legal 15 holidays * * *: (a) The first day of January, designated as New Year's 16 17 Day; (b) The third Monday of January * * *, designated as 18 19 Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday; ~ OFFICIAL ~ G1/2 H. 20 The third Monday of February, designated as George (C) 21 Washington's birthday; 22 The last Monday of April, designated as Confederate (d) 23 Memorial Day and Robert E. Lee's birthday; 24 The last Monday of May, designated as both National (e) 25 Memorial Day and Jefferson Davis' birthday; The fourth day of July, designated as Independence 26 (f) 27 Day; 28 The first Monday of September, designated as Labor (g) 29 Day; 30 (h) The eleventh day of November, designated as 31 Armistice or Veterans' Day; 32 (i) The day fixed by proclamation by the Governor of Mississippi as a day of Thanksgiving, which shall be fixed to 33 correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the United 34 35 States, designated as Thanksgiving Day; and 36 The twenty-fifth day of December, designated as (j) 37 Christmas Day. 38 * * * If any legal holiday * * * falls on a Sunday, then the 39 next following day shall be a legal holiday. 40 (2) In lieu of any one (1) legal holiday provided for in subsection (1) of this section, with the exception of the third 41 Monday in January * * *, designated as Dr. Martin Luther King, 42 Jr.'s birthday, and the eleventh day of November, designated as 43 Armistice or Veterans' Day, the governing authorities of any 44

45 municipality or county may declare, by order spread upon its 46 minutes, Mardi Gras Day or any one (1) other day during the year, 47 to be a legal holiday.

48 (3) August 16 is declared to be Elvis Aaron Presley Day in 49 recognition and appreciation of Elvis Aaron Presley's many 50 contributions, international recognition and the rich legacy left 51 to us by Elvis Aaron Presley. This day shall be a day of 52 recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal 53 holiday.

54 May 8 is declared to be Hernando de Soto Day in (4) 55 recognition, observation and commemoration of Hernando de Soto, 56 who led the first and most imposing expedition ever made by 57 Europeans into the wilds of North America and the State of 58 Mississippi, and in further recognition of the Spanish explorer's 59 187-day journey from the Tombigbee River basin on our state's 60 eastern boundary, westward to the place of discovery of the 61 Mississippi River on May 8, 1541. This day shall be a day of commemoration, recognition and observation of Hernando de Soto and 62 63 European exploration and shall not be recognized as a legal 64 holiday.

(5) Armistice * * * <u>or</u> Veterans' Day shall be observed by appropriate exercises in all the public schools in the State of Mississippi. The superintendent of schools of each public school district is authorized to provide for the appearance of uniformed military personnel, uniformed veterans or the families of fallen

The superintendent of 72 schools is also authorized to permit the school band and its 73 director(s) at any public school in the district to perform at 74 Armistice * * * or Veterans' Day exercises in the school district upon the request of public officials or veterans associations 75 76 without loss of any program credit by participating students and 77 without loss of leave by participating school personnel.

78 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after July 1, 2024.
