HOUSE BILL NO. 123

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 PROVIDE THAT IF ANY LEGAL HOLIDAY FALLS ON A TUESDAY, THEN THE DAY 3 BEFORE SUCH TUESDAY SHALL BE A LEGAL HOLIDAY; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 3-3-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) 9 of this section, the following are declared to be legal holidays, 10 viz: the first day of January (New Year's Day); the third Monday of January (Robert E. Lee's birthday and Dr. Martin Luther King, 11 12 Jr.'s birthday); the third Monday of February (Washington's birthday); the last Monday of April (Confederate Memorial Day); 13 14 the last Monday of May (National Memorial Day and Jefferson Davis' birthday); the fourth day of July (Independence Day); the first 15 Monday of September (Labor Day); the eleventh day of November 16 17 (Armistice or Veterans' Day); the day fixed by proclamation by the Governor of Mississippi as a day of Thanksgiving, which shall be 18 19 fixed to correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the ~ OFFICIAL ~ G1/2 H. 20 United States (Thanksgiving Day); and the twenty-fifth day of 21 December (Christmas Day). * * * <u>If</u> any <u>legal</u> holiday * * *falls 22 on <u>a</u> Sunday, then the next following day shall be a legal 23 holiday * * *, and if any legal holiday falls on Tuesday, then the 24 day before such Tuesday shall be a legal holiday.

(2) In lieu of any one (1) legal holiday provided for in
subsection (1) of this section, with the exception of the third
Monday in January (Robert E. Lee's and Martin Luther King, Jr.'s
birthday) and the eleventh day of November (Armistice or Veterans'
Day), the governing authorities of any municipality or county may
declare, by order spread upon its minutes, Mardi Gras Day or any
one (1) other day during the year, to be a legal holiday.

32 (3) August 16 is declared to be Elvis Aaron Presley Day in
33 recognition and appreciation of Elvis Aaron Presley's many
34 contributions, international recognition and the rich legacy left
35 to us by Elvis Aaron Presley. This day shall be a day of
36 recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal
37 holiday.

(4) May 8 is declared to be Hernando de Soto Day in recognition, observation and commemoration of Hernando de Soto, who led the first and most imposing expedition ever made by Europeans into the wilds of North America and the State of Mississippi, and in further recognition of the Spanish explorer's 187-day journey from the Tombigbee River basin on our state's eastern boundary, westward to the place of discovery of the

45 Mississippi River on May 8, 1541. This day shall be a day of 46 commemoration, recognition and observation of Hernando de Soto and 47 European exploration and shall not be recognized as a legal 48 holiday.

49 (5) Armistice Day (Veterans' Day) shall be observed by 50 appropriate exercises in all the public schools in the State of Mississippi. The superintendent of schools of each public school 51 52 district is authorized to provide for the appearance of uniformed 53 military personnel, uniformed veterans or the families of fallen military personnel/veterans at such public school exercises in 54 55 honor of Armistice (Veterans') Day. The superintendent of schools 56 is also authorized to permit the school band and its director(s) 57 at any public school in the district to perform at Armistice (Veterans') Day exercises in the school district upon the request 58 59 of public officials or veterans associations without loss of any 60 program credit by participating students and without loss of leave 61 by participating school personnel.

62 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 63 and after its passage.
