HOUSE BILL NO. 124

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 3-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 DESIGNATE THE FOURTH THURSDAY OF MARCH AS TUSKEGEE AIRMEN DAY IN 3 MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: **SECTION 1.** Section 3-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 3-3-7. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (2) 7 of this section, the following are declared to be legal holidays, 8 9 viz: the first day of January (New Year's Day); the third Monday of January (Robert E. Lee's birthday and Dr. Martin Luther King, 10 11 Jr.'s birthday); the third Monday of February (Washington's birthday); the last Monday of April (Confederate Memorial Day); 12 the last Monday of May (National Memorial Day and Jefferson Davis' 13 14 birthday); the fourth day of July (Independence Day); the first Monday of September (Labor Day); the eleventh day of November 15 16 (Armistice or Veterans' Day); the day fixed by proclamation by the Governor of Mississippi as a day of Thanksgiving, which shall be 17 18 fixed to correspond to the date proclaimed by the President of the

H. B. No. 124 G1/2 24/HR26/R41.1 PAGE 1 (MCL\KW) 19 United States (Thanksgiving Day); and the twenty-fifth day of 20 December (Christmas Day). In the event any holiday hereinbefore 21 declared legal shall fall on Sunday, then the next following day 22 shall be a legal holiday.

(2) In lieu of any one (1) legal holiday provided for in
subsection (1) of this section, with the exception of the third
Monday in January (Robert E. Lee's and Martin Luther King, Jr.'s
birthday) and the eleventh day of November (Armistice or Veterans'
Day), the governing authorities of any municipality or county may
declare, by order spread upon its minutes, Mardi Gras Day or any
one (1) other day during the year, to be a legal holiday.

30 (3) August 16 is declared to be Elvis Aaron Presley Day in 31 recognition and appreciation of Elvis Aaron Presley's many 32 contributions, international recognition and the rich legacy left 33 to us by Elvis Aaron Presley. This day shall be a day of 34 recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal 35 holiday.

May 8 is declared to be Hernando de Soto Day in 36 (4) 37 recognition, observation and commemoration of Hernando de Soto, 38 who led the first and most imposing expedition ever made by 39 Europeans into the wilds of North America and the State of 40 Mississippi, and in further recognition of the Spanish explorer's 41 187-day journey from the Tombigbee River basin on our state's 42 eastern boundary, westward to the place of discovery of the Mississippi River on May 8, 1541. This day shall be a day of 43

44 commemoration, recognition and observation of Hernando de Soto and 45 European exploration and shall not be recognized as a legal 46 holiday.

Armistice Day (Veterans' Day) shall be observed by 47 (5)48 appropriate exercises in all the public schools in the State of 49 Mississippi. The superintendent of schools of each public school 50 district is authorized to provide for the appearance of uniformed 51 military personnel, uniformed veterans or the families of fallen 52 military personnel/veterans at such public school exercises in 53 honor of Armistice (Veterans') Day. The superintendent of schools 54 is also authorized to permit the school band and its director(s) 55 at any public school in the district to perform at Armistice 56 (Veterans') Day exercises in the school district upon the request 57 of public officials or veterans associations without loss of any 58 program credit by participating students and without loss of leave 59 by participating school personnel.

60 (6) In recognition of the service, courage and sacrifice of
 61 the valiant service members of the Tuskegee Airmen who served
 62 during World War II, the fourth Thursday of March is designated as
 63 <u>Tuskegee Airmen Day in Mississippi. This should be a day of</u>
 64 <u>recognition and observation and shall not be recognized as a legal</u>
 65 <u>holiday.</u>

66 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 67 and after its passage.
