- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** (1) No school board shall adopt and implement
- 10 any cafeteria or food service policy that requires students who
- 11 bring any commercially prepared food or beverage product as part
- 12 of their lunch to conceal the identity of such product by removing
- 13 it from its original packaging or covering any identifiable brand
- 14 name, label or logo.
- 15 (2) Any school board that has previously adopted and
- 16 implemented a policy as described in subsection (1), which is
- 17 currently enforced by school district employees shall rescind the
- 18 policy.
- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2024.
