## HOUSE BILL NO. 383

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 17-25-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
- 2 TO PROHIBIT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY OR THE
- 3 GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF ANY MUNICIPALITY FROM ENACTING OR ENFORCING
- 4 ORDINANCES AUTHORIZING THE USE OF AUTOMATED RECORDING EQUIPMENT OR
- 5 SYSTEMS TO ENFORCE COMPLIANCE WITH AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE
- 6 REQUIREMENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 **SECTION 1.** Section 17-25-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 17-25-19. (1) (a) Neither the board of supervisors of any
- 11 county nor the governing authority of any municipality shall
- 12 adopt, enact or enforce any ordinance authorizing the use of
- 13 automated recording equipment or system to enforce compliance with
- 14 automobile insurance requirements, traffic signals, traffic speeds
- 15 or other traffic laws, rules or regulations on any public street,
- 16 road or highway within this state or to impose or collect any
- 17 civil or criminal fine, fee or penalty for any such violation.
- 18 (b) Any county or municipality using automated
- 19 recording equipment or system shall remove the equipment or system
- 20 before October 1, 2009.

2.1	(c) Any county or municipality using automated
22	recording equipment or system to enforce compliance with
23	automobile insurance requirements shall remove the equipment or
24	system before October 1, 2024.
25	(2) For the purposes of this section, the term "automated
26	recording equipment or system" means a camera or optical device
27	installed to work in conjunction with a traffic control signal or
28	radar speed detection equipment, or both, and designed to record
9	images that depict the license plate attached to the rear of a
80	motor vehicle that is not operated in compliance with instructions
31	of the traffic control signal or the posted speed limit.
32	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
