HOUSE BILL NO. 697

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI AVIATION SAFETY ACT; TO 2 DEFINE TERMINOLOGY; TO PROVIDE THAT BEGINNING JULY 1, 2024, THE 3 OWNING ENTITY OF ALL EXISTING OR NEWLY CONSTRUCTED COVERED TOWERS 4 AND STRUCTURES THAT HAVE HEIGHT MEASUREMENTS OF MORE THAN 50 FEET 5 BUT LESS THAN 200 FEET SHALL CAUSE SUCH TOWER OR STRUCTURE TO BE 6 CLEARLY MARKED CONSISTENT WITH APPLICABLE GUIDANCE IN THE FAA 7 ADVISORY CIRCULAR (AC 70/7460 IL) TO REQUIRE THE OWNING ENTITY OF A NEWLY CONSTRUCTED STRUCTURE, BEFORE THE COMPLETION OF 8 9 CONSTRUCTION OF THE STRUCTURE TO DISCLOSE THE HEIGHT, THE PRECISE 10 LOCATION OF LATITUDINAL AND LONGITUDINAL COORDINATES OF THE 11 COVERED TOWER OR STRUCTURE AND THE TYPE OF OBSTRUCTION MARKING OR 12 LIGHTING TO THE APPROPRIATE ENTITY BY ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION 13 WITH THE APPROPRIATE ENTITIES; TO REQUIRE THE APPROPRIATE ENTITIES KEEP THEIR DATABASES CURRENT TO PROTECT ANY PROPRIETARY 14 15 INFORMATION CONTAINED THEREIN; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

17 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the

18 "Mississippi Aviation Safety Act."

19 SECTION 2. As used in this act the following terms shall

20 have the meanings ascribed in this section, unless context clearly 21 requires otherwise.

(a) "Agricultural purposes" means farming in all its 22 23 branches and the cultivation and tillage of the soil, the

production, cultivation, growing and harvesting of any 24

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25 agricultural or horticultural commodities performed by a farmer or 26 on a farm, or on pasture land or rangeland.

(b) "Appropriate entities" means the Federal Aviation
Administration and the Mississippi Agricultural Aviation
Association.

"Covered tower" means a structure that: 30 (C) (i) Is a meteorological evaluation tower 31 1. 32 (MET), a self-standing tower, real-time kinematic tower or tower 33 supported by guy wires and ground anchors; 34 2. Is ten (10) feet or less in diameter at 35 the above-ground base, excluding the concrete footing; 36 At the highest point of the structure, is 3. 37 at least fifty (50) feet above ground level; 38 4. At the highest point of the structure, is 39 not more than two hundred (200) feet above ground level; 40 5. Has accessory facilities on which an antenna, sensor, camera, meteorological instrument or other 41 equipment is mounted to document whether a site has sufficient 42 43 wind resources to operate a wind turbine generator; and 6. Is located on land that is in a rural area 44 45 and used for agricultural purposes or, immediately adjacent to 46 such land; 47 (ii) "Covered tower" does not include any structure 48 that:

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 49 1. Is a street light erected or maintained by 50 a federal, state, local, or tribal entity; 51 2. Is an advertising billboard; 52 3. Is registered with the Federal 53 Communications Commission under the Antenna Structure Registration 54 program set forth under Part 17 of Title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, and is determined by the FAA Administrator to pose no 55 56 hazard to air navigation; or 57 4. Has already mitigated any hazard to aviation safety in accordance with Federal Aviation Administration 58 59 quidance or as otherwise approved by the Administrator. 60 "Real-time kinematic (RTK) position tower" means a (d) 61 tower used to supplement the global positioning system (GPS) to provide highly accurate positioning and navigation data technology 62 in a wide range of applications, from surveying and mapping to 63 64 agriculture and construction. 65 "Rural area" means a city, town or unincorporated (e) area that has a population of not more than ten thousand (10,000) 66 67 inhabitants, as defined in the Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act of 1978 (7 USCS Section 918c(a)(5)). 68 69 (f) "Structure" means, but is not limited to, 70 meteorological evaluation towers, real-time kinematic positioning 71 towers, an currently unregulated nondisclosed structures greater 72 than fifty (50) feet and less than two hundred (200) feet in

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SECTION 3. (1) Beginning on July 1, 2024, pursuant to the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 and use of the database developed by the FAA Administrator, the owning entity of all existing or newly constructed covered towers and structures, whether regulated or unregulated nondisclosed within the state, and before the completion of construction of the structure, shall, by electronic communication with the appropriate entities, disclose:

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(a) The height of such covered tower or structure;(b) The precise location of latitudinal and longitudinal coordinates; and

85 (c) The type of obstruction marking or lighting, if86 any.

(2) (a) The appropriate entities shall keep the databases
for which they are responsible for maintaining, current to the
extent practicable, and ensure that any proprietary information in
the database is protected from disclosure in accordance with law,
which shall be accessible via the entities' website or develop
mobile application.

93 (b) The appropriate entities shall ensure that, by
94 virtue of accessing the database, users agree and acknowledge that
95 information in the database:

96 (i) May only be used for aviation safety purposes; 97 and

98 (ii) May not be disclosed for purposes other than
99 aviation safety, regardless of whether or not the information is
100 marked or labeled as proprietary or with a similar designation.
101 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
102 and after July 1, 2024.
