19 To assist the elected state and district officers in (2)20 subsection (1) of this section in efficiently performing the 21 official duties imposed upon him or her by law, the officer may 22 employ suitable and competent persons who possess the professional 23 skill and expert knowledge needed to fulfill those duties. The State Personnel Board, based upon its findings of fact, shall 24 25 exempt those persons from the provisions of Section 25-3-39 when the acquisition of such professional services is precluded based 26 27 upon the prevailing wage in the relevant labor market. This 28 subsection (2) shall stand repealed on July 1, * * * 2027.

29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 30 and after July 1, 2024.
