## HOUSE BILL NO. 834

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 WHICH AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE LICENSE 3 TAGS TO MEMBERS AND CERTAIN FORMER MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, FOR THE PURPOSES OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 brought forward as follows: 27-19-56.3. (1) (a) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is an 8 9 elected member of the Mississippi House of Representatives or 10 Mississippi Senate, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, upon 11 12 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of 13 14 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in 15 subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive 16 17 license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name. Each distinctive license tag issued under this section shall have 18 19 displayed thereon the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi and

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- 20 the word "HOUSE" or "SENATE," as appropriate, and, in addition
- 21 thereto, such numbers or letters, or both, as may be necessary to
- 22 distinguish each license tag. The State Tax Commission shall
- 23 determine the color and design of each distinctive license tag
- 24 issued under this section and whether or not a county name shall
- 25 be required to be displayed on the tag.
- 26 (b) Any owner of a motor vehicle who served at least
- 27 two (2) complete four (4) year terms as an elected member of the
- 28 Mississippi House of Representatives or Mississippi Senate, and
- 29 who is receiving retirement compensation under the Public
- 30 Employees' Retirement System created under Section 25-11-101,
- 31 and/or the Supplemental Legislative Retirement Plan created under
- 32 Section 25-11-301, upon complying with the motor vehicle laws
- 33 relating to registration and licensing of motor vehicles, upon
- 34 payment of the road and bridge privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes
- 35 and registration fees as prescribed by law for private carriers of
- 36 passengers, pickup trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles,
- 37 and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in
- 38 subsection (3) of this section, shall be issued a distinctive
- 39 license tag for each motor vehicle registered in his name. Each
- 40 distinctive license tag issued under this section shall have
- 41 displayed thereon the Great Seal of the State of Mississippi and
- 42 the words "RETIRED HOUSE" or "RETIRED SENATE," as appropriate,
- 43 and, in addition thereto, such numbers or letters, or both, as may
- 44 be necessary to distinguish each license tag. The State Tax

- 45 Commission shall determine the color and design of each
- 46 distinctive license tag issued under this section and whether or
- 47 not a county name shall be required to be displayed on the tag.
- 48 (2) Application for the distinctive license tags authorized
- 49 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms
- 50 prescribed by the State Tax Commission. The application and the
- 51 additional fee imposed under subsection (3) of this section, less
- 52 three percent (3%) thereof to be retained by the tax collector,
- 53 shall be remitted to the State Tax Commission on a monthly basis
- 54 as prescribed by the commission. The portion of the additional
- 55 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the
- 56 county general fund.
- 57 (3) Any person applying for a distinctive license tag under
- 58 this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount of Fifty
- 59 Dollars (\$50.00) for each distinctive license tag applied for
- 60 under this section which shall be in addition to all other taxes
- 61 and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time
- 62 to run concurrent with the vehicle's established license tag year.
- 63 The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original
- 64 application is made for a distinctive license tag under this
- 65 section and thereafter annually at the time of renewal
- 66 registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive license
- 67 tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive license
- 68 tag, or if the owner retires or resigns from or otherwise vacates

- his membership in the Legislature, he must surrender the tag to the local county tax collector.
- 71 (4) The State Tax Commission shall deposit all fees
- 72 collected under this section into the State Treasury on the day
- 73 collected. At the end of each month, the State Tax Commission
- 74 shall certify to the State Treasurer the total fees collected
- 75 under this section from the issuance of distinctive license tags.
- 76 The State Treasurer shall distribute an amount equal to Seven
- 77 Dollars (\$7.00) of the additional fees collected for each such
- 78 distinctive license tag issued under this section to the State
- 79 General Fund, and the remainder of such additional fees collected
- 80 shall be distributed by the State Treasurer to the credit of the
- 81 special fund created in Section 7-9-70.
- 82 (5) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as
- 83 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under
- 84 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the
- 85 tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under
- 86 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license
- 87 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section,
- 88 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license
- 89 tag.
- 90 (6) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license
- 91 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and
- 92 affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by
- 93 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license

- 94 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving
- 95 such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and
- 96 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee
- 97 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be
- 98 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular
- 99 distinctive license tags issued under this section.
- 100 (7) (a) In addition to any other provisions of this
- 101 section, any person eligible for a distinctive license tag under
- 102 this section may, regardless of whether the person obtains such a
- 103 license tag, obtain a replica tag of the distinctive license tag
- 104 authorized in this section. A replica tag may not be displayed on
- 105 any motor vehicle and may not be used for any motor vehicle
- 106 license tag purpose. A person may obtain a replica tag from the
- 107 Department of Revenue and the additional fee for the tag shall be
- 108 the cost of the replica tag and any applicable shipping or
- 109 delivery charge or other related charge incurred by the
- 110 department.
- 111 (b) In addition to any other provisions of this
- 112 section, any owner of a motor vehicle who served at least six (6)
- 113 years as an elected member of the Mississippi House of
- 114 Representatives or Mississippi Senate may obtain a replica tag of
- 115 the distinctive license tag authorized in subsection (1)(a) of
- 116 this section for which the person would be eligible to obtain if
- 117 the person were serving as an elected member of the Mississippi
- 118 House of Representatives or Mississippi Senate. A replica tag may

119	not be displayed on any motor vehicle and may not be used for any
120	motor vehicle license tag purpose. A person may obtain a replica
121	tag from the Department of Revenue and the additional fee for the
122	tag shall be the cost of the replica tag and any applicable
123	shipping or delivery charge or other related charge incurred by
124	the department.
