- 9 (2) The three (3) judgeships shall be separate and distinct
- 10 and denominated for purposes of appointment and election only as
- 11 "Place One \* \* \*", "Place Two \* \* \*", and "Place Three \* \* \*".
- 12 The judge to fill Place One must be a resident of Jefferson Davis,
- 13 Lamar, Lawrence or Marion County. The judge to fill Place Two may
- 14 be a resident of any county in the district. The judge to fill
- 15 Place Three must be a resident of \* \* \* Jefferson Davis, Lawrence
- 16 or Marion County.
- 17 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 18 and after July 1, 2024.
