HOUSE BILL NO. 874

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE SALARY SCALE FOR OFFICERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL AND THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF NARCOTICS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL SALARY INCREASE FOR THE FIRST EIGHT YEARS OF 5 EMPLOYMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN 6 ADDITIONAL TIERED ANNUAL EDUCATION SUPPLEMENTAL PAY FOR OFFICERS 7 WHO HOLD A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE OR GREATER FROM AN ACCREDITED 8 COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- **SECTION 1.** Section 45-1-12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10

- general law enforcement, and are serving as a sworn officer of the 15

- Mississippi, including service in any other division of the 17
- Department of Public Safety, and the sworn law enforcement 18
- 19 officers of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics, shall be

159	officers employed by the department.

- (* * *8) The Commissioner of Public Safety, with approval
 by the State Personnel Board, is authorized to set the salaries
 equitably of sworn law enforcement officers assigned to the
 Commercial Transportation Enforcement Division and Capitol Police
 based upon the pay scale contained in this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024.
