HOUSE BILL NO. 893

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-56.549, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 2 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF DISTINCTIVE MOTOR VEHICLE 3 LICENSE TAGS TO SUPPORTERS OF THE NAVY SEABLE FOUNDATION; AND FOR 4 RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 27-19-56.549, Mississippi Code of 1972, 6 7 is amended as follows: 27-19-56.549. (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a 8 9 resident of this state, upon payment of the road and bridge 10 privilege taxes, ad valorem taxes and registration fees as 11 prescribed by law for private carriers of passengers, pickup 12 trucks and other noncommercial motor vehicles, and upon payment of an additional fee in the amount provided in subsection (4) of this 13 14 section, shall be issued a distinctive license tag for any motor vehicle registered in his name identifying such person as a 15 supporter of any one (1) of the following: 16 17 (a) Mississippi Association of Nurse Practitioners; 18 (b) \* \* \* Navy Seabee Foundation;

(2) The distinctive license tags so issued shall be of such color and design as the Department of Revenue, with the advice of the respective beneficiary organization listed in subsection (1) of this section, may prescribe and shall consist of such letters or numbers, or both, as may be necessary to distinguish each license tag.

Application for the distinctive license tags authorized 51 (3) 52 by this section shall be made to the county tax collector on forms 53 prescribed by the Department of Revenue. The application and the additional fee imposed under subsection (4) of this section, less 54 55 Two Dollars (\$2.00) thereof to be retained by the tax collector, 56 shall be remitted to the Department of Revenue on a monthly basis 57 as prescribed by the department. The portion of the additional 58 fee retained by the tax collector shall be deposited into the 59 county general fund.

60 Beginning with any registration year commencing on or (4) after July 1, 2022, any person applying for a distinctive license 61 62 tag under this section shall pay an additional fee in the amount 63 of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) for each distinctive license tag 64 applied for under this section, which shall be in addition to all 65 other taxes and fees. The additional fee paid shall be for a period of time to run concurrently with the vehicle's established 66 67 license tag year. The additional fee is due and payable at the time the original application is made for a distinctive license 68

69 tag under this section and thereafter annually at the time of 70 renewal registration as long as the owner retains the distinctive 71 license tag. If the owner does not wish to retain the distinctive 72 license tag, he must surrender it to the local county tax 73 collector.

74 (5) The Department of Revenue shall deposit all fees into the State Treasury on the day collected. At the end of each 75 76 month, the Department of Revenue shall certify to the State 77 Treasurer the total fees collected under this section from the 78 issuance of the distinctive license tags issued under this 79 The State Treasurer shall distribute such collections as section. 80 follows:

81 (a) Twenty-four Dollars (\$24.00) of each additional fee
82 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
83 section shall be distributed to the appropriate beneficiary
84 organization listed in subsection (1) of this section.

(b) One Dollar (\$1.00) of each additional fee collected
on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this section shall
be deposited into the Mississippi Burn Care Fund created pursuant
to Section 7-9-70.

89 (c) Two Dollars (\$2.00) of each additional fee
90 collected on distinctive license tags issued pursuant to this
91 section shall be deposited to the credit of the State Highway Fund
92 to be expended solely for the repair, maintenance, construction or
93 reconstruction of highways.

98 (6) A regular license tag must be properly displayed as 99 required by law until replaced by a distinctive license tag under 100 this section. The regular license tag must be surrendered to the tax collector upon issuance of the distinctive license tag under 101 102 this section. The tax collector shall issue up to two (2) license 103 decals for each distinctive license tag issued under this section, 104 which will expire the same month and year as the regular license 105 tag.

106 (7) In the case of loss or theft of a distinctive license 107 tag issued under this section, the owner may make application and affidavit for a replacement distinctive license tag as provided by 108 Section 27-19-37. The fee for a replacement distinctive license 109 110 tag shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00). The tax collector receiving such application and affidavit shall be entitled to retain and 111 112 deposit into the county general fund five percent (5%) of the fee 113 for such replacement license tag and the remainder shall be 114 distributed in the same manner as funds from the sale of regular 115 distinctive license tags issued under this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 116 and after July 1, 2024. 117
